1	Matters/Actions arising from last minutes	Town Tidy – The next event is 5 <sup>th</sup> Aug. Sharon has made posters to go in shop windows and notice-boards. Highland Broadband (HB) – New HB offer has gone out in Newsletter Dornoch Town Wi-Fi – Colin is in discussions with HB, but it has STILL not gone liveHopefully better news next month. Jobs Page – 'Live North' page is due to be complete end July. CB to include a link on our website.  Opt-in fees table approved last month to be actioned ASAP Proposed Closure of HC Service Point – GK has sent BID objection letter. Luke Watson has also sent one from DACIC RDGC Matters  - RD have offered a 25% visitor Green Fee reduction for AHFF - RD, Brora, Tain & Golspie GC's now involved in working out a successor to the old Dornoch Firth Golf Pass, to encourage visitors to stay in the area for longer. 2	Finance - monthly report  Grant Progress  Development of "We are Dornoch" proposal	Adoption of minutes - Proposed JD, and seconded CM  Accounts are in a good position, with £51 k on deposit, earning interest at 0.7%.  Grant Funding Application Updates  - There was more discussion ref why BID's applications to CGF were so unsuccessful (£8k granted out of >£30k). CB to email Cath MacAngus for a written explanation. BID would like to know what criteria decisions are based on.  - Highland 3 <sup>rd</sup> sector interface will report back on our application at beginning of August.  'We Are Dornoch' crowdfunding initiative update.  - Meetings with DACIC and DADCA chairs successfully held. Luke Watson & Donald Goskirk both on board in principle with concept of crowdfunding body being linked to them and funding DADCA, DACIC and BID initiatives.  - "We are Dornoch" Team have proposed pushing ahead with a "trial run" to be publicised at the Town Tidy on August 5 <sup>th</sup> .  - Logo ideas were circulated and liked. 4	Dornoch Place Plan	Lou has advised that she expects to have the first draft of the Dornoch Place Plan ready for first round of consultation by the end of August	
5	Signage – Possible CC "A frame" purge	Chris Fearne from CC has raised question whether CC should have a purge on proliferating business A frame signs in our (conservation zone) town centre. The signs probably detract from the town's attractiveness, even if they work for individual businesses. Plus, probably only 1 sign has the required planning permission. There are currently 10 on the green, 8 along in front of the Castle/Jail/Courthouse, and 5 in the square - plus more elsewhere. NB: A number of these signs are within the individual businesses' curtilage.  Agreed GK should contact CF with some suggestions, including that the CC might help BID access more Common Good Funds, so that the proposed signage project be completed in full.	GK
6	Events Update/ AHFF	SM produced a very encouraging timetable of events for the Autumn Highland Festival Fortnight. There was real enthusiasm for some new events, eg a potential Tartan fashion show, possibly in Cathedral. We noted that it would be good if there could be a Community Market on the Cathedral Green during the fortnight. Also a Farmers Market at Dornoch South.
